

# LIVE UNITED NEIGHBORHOOD GRANTS

United Way of Pierce County's Neighborhood Grants provide financial and technical support to resident or community-led groups for projects that help children and families in their neighborhood.

## WHO SHOULD APPLY

Any Pierce County community-led groups in the Bethel, Franklin Pierce, Sumner or Eastside (Salishan) neighborhoods are eligible to apply this year. Each group must include at least four volunteers.

## CRITERIA



**IMPACT:** Will the group's project achieve positive changes for their community in either areas of:

- 1) *Building Strong Families* by creating neighborhood opportunities to build a stable home environment
- 2) *Meeting Basic Needs* of families by creating projects that invest in food, housing and other essential needs



Projects must be carried out in the neighborhood or community where the members live. Check online for additional project criteria such as the recipient must be a community or resident-led group and hasn't been funded more than two times in the Neighborhood Grants process.

## APPLICATION DETAILS

Applications must be submitted online by **March 10, 2019**. The process takes under 30 minutes so submit today. Only one application per group will be considered.

## GRANT AWARDS

In 2019, the Neighborhood Grants Program will be awarding chosen groups in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$1,500. Funding will be awarded in a single disbursement during the month of April. Grantees will be required to submit a final report in order to be eligible to apply again next year.
