United Way of Pierce County's Neighborhood Grants provide financial and technical support to resident or community-led groups for projects that help children and families in their neighborhood.

WHO SHOULD APPLY

Any Pierce County community-led groups in the Buckley, Franklin Pierce, Key Peninsula or Orting neighborhoods are eligible to apply this year. Each group must include at least four volunteers.



United Way of Pierce County's Mission is: We work from the heart to unite caring people to tackle our community's toughest challenges.

- Projects must aim to achieve positive changes in their community and identified challenge, plans to address it, and the change the project will bring.
- Projects must be carried out in the neighborhood or community where the members live.
- Check online for additional project criteria such as the recipient must be a community
 or resident-led group and hasn't been funded more than two times in the Neighborhood Grants process.

All grant information, application materials and criteria are available online at www.uwpc.org/neighborhood-grants. Applications must be submitted online by **April 5, 2019**. The process takes under 30 minutes so submit today. Only one application per group will be considered.

2019 GRANT AWARDS

In 2019, the Neighborhood Grants Program will be awarding chosen groups in amounts ranging from \$500 to \$1,500. Funding will be awarded in a single disbursement during the month of April. Grantees will be required to submit a final report in order to be eligible to apply again next year.
