From Poverty to Possibilities (P2P) is Pierce County's signature community summit that takes on barriers to economic equity. This year's event will be held in the Pavilion at the Hotel Murano. Last year we had over 250 community leaders and community members attend.

Now in its seventh year, P2P brings the community together to disrupt poverty at its roots. This summit creates a safe space for the community to have an open dialogue on how to dismantle the systems of exclusion. From these relationships a new narrative has evolved, and systems are more open to change.

This year's summit will continue to focus on how we deconstruct the narrative with those in poverty and move towards disrupting the systems that create barriers for those in poverty. We ask; What is our role in disrupting the status quo? How do we leverage our individual and collective appetite for leaning into being "comfortable with being uncomfortable" in our work to disrupt poverty? Lastly, how do we build a just and equitable community that is resilient as a result?


