#### Ensuring there are Emergency Services for People in Need

Operated by United Way of Pierce County, South Sound 2-1-1 is a free, confidential, one-stop, online and phone line resource that increases the efficiency of connecting people, who are experiencing a human services crisis

with the appropriate program or service they need. Last year, South Sound 211 fielded nearly 90,000 calls throughout Pierce, Thurston and Lewis Counties. And thanks to specialized 2-1-1 Navigators, we were able to provide individuals and families with 583 rides, 334 food benefits and 47 stable housing.

South Sound 2-1-1 reports on what needs are being presented in the community, how they are being met and who is helping to meet those needs. 2-1-1 specialists collect specific caller information based on location of caller, gender and age.


