- Help prep and serve meals
- Open 7 days a week
- Approximately 2 hours

- Flexible schedule (weather dependent)
- Daily meal prep between 5:30 am - 1:30 pm
- Ongoing

• Paint Tacoma Beautiful - Associated Ministries

- Prep and paint houses
